2017 Woodcutters Rosé

The 2017 Woodcutter's Rose is unashamedly modeled after the fabulously rich, gloriously scented and bone dry Rosés of Provence, by adopting the traditional French method of Saignée.

In essence we bled off some juice from selected Mataro vineyards.

A soft floral nose with hints of thyme, dried strawberry and charcuterie all give way to a palate full of refreshing red berry fruits and spice with a long savoury finish.

Like all serious Rosés, this years Rosé is best served lightly chilled and is a great accompaniment to Asian styled cuisine and anything from the sea.

VARIETAL: 100% Mataro
REGIONS: Dorrien, Kalimna, Vine Vale
HARVEST: 4th to 12th May 2017
pH: 3.37
ACIDITY: 5.38g/L
ALCOHOL: 13% Alc/Vol

VINEYARDS & VINIFICATION: The fruit was handpicked from three individual sites. After approximately 12 hours of skin contact the juice was gently bled from the fermenters. Following fermentation a portion was matured in seasoned 300L French oak hogsheads while the other portion is kept in stainless steel tanks preserving colour and freshness prior to blending and bottling.
