Sourced from the devigorated soils of western Greenock, Les Amis is a testament to what only the most fastidious farming can achieve - purity, intensity and finesse.

A multi layered perfume of violets, kirsch and concentrated red berry aromas with a succulent, dense and vibrant fruit intensity. The concentration, poise and elegance is perfectly balanced and typical of this unique terroir.

Revealing a savoury elegance in its youth, the Les Amis will continue to build in complexity for many years to come.

VARIETAL: 100% Grenache

VINEYARD: Slade Vineyard- easterly aspect, dry grown

SUB REGION: Greenock

HARVESTED: 21st March 2013

pH: 3.63

ACIDITY: 5.67g/L

ALCOHOL: 15.50%

FERMENTATION:

After being hand harvesting on the 21st March this unique small batch of fruit was destemmed into a single cement vat where it spent 8 days being pumped over twice daily, before being gently basket pressed directly into new French barriques. After 24 months maturation the barrels are carefully racked and assembled for bottling. The wine was left to settle and bottled in August 2015 without the use of fining or filtration.
